

Your New Families

Please continue to keep your new families in the loop. 4-H has many due dates and activities that are available. New people do not always know about these opportunities. Please help them out by explaining what the activity is and what is involved. They will be much more likely to return for more years of 4-H involvement if this happens.

Pictures/Video

We would like you to collect pictures during the year of your 4-H activities to be shown during the 4-H Achievement Banquet 2017. It would work best if you could take a group photo as well as a couple of other pictures, Ex: your club participates in a parade – take some photos of people getting ready or during the parade, but then take a group photo of everyone. This way we will be able to get photos of everyone in your club without having to use 10

pictures each time (with 11 clubs that will get very lengthy). We would like you to put the pictures on a jump drive. Please be selective as there should not be a large number of pictures, just the highlights. The only way we will accept the pictures is on a jump drive. This is a very time consuming project and we MUST have the jump drive in the Extension Office by September 1, 2017. It is always fun to watch the highlights of a year, especially if you are a participant. Please designate someone in your club to be in charge of taking pictures – sounds like a new officer position (or Junior Officer) to me 😊 Thank you for helping to make this happen.

4-H Volunteer Orientation

If you are a new volunteer (as of October 1, 2017) you must complete the online orientation or you can come into the office for a face to face session. To complete this online you need to login to 4honline, continue to your family, click ‘edit’ next to your name, then at the top click ‘trainings’, click ‘sign up for trainings’. This will bring up the videos and quizzes for you to take. Each video is between 2 and 5 minutes. The quiz may be taken after each video. I will receive an email letting me know you have completed the orientation so you do not need to send the certificate to me.

Volunteer Renewal

If you are currently a volunteer you will need to fill out a renewal form (contact Julie). This is a short form and must be completed by Jan 31, 2018.


