2021 Labette County Fair Updates and Reminders:

- The Judging and Show Schedule has changed. Be sure to take a look and note when your project judging/show time is.
- Pre-Fair Foods Judging Monday, July 12 at 1:00 p.m.
- Pre-Fair Clothing Judging Tuesday, July 13 at 9:00 a.m.
- NEW FOR 2021, THERE WILL BE A MANDATORY LIVESTOCK EXHIBITOR
 MEEITNG ON MONDAY, JULY 19 AT 1:00 P.M. ALL LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS
 MUST BE PRESENT. Any exhibitor that is unable to attend must meet with
 their livestock department superintendent prior to the meeting.
- Only 3 market animals per exhibitor per specie may be nominated.
- Sheep & Goats: There will be no body clipping or shearing on the fairgrounds. All body clipping, and shearing must be done prior to vet check at fair.
- Sheep and Goats may be nominated for county fair using their scrapie tag.
 The scrapie tag must be clearly read.
- Market Beef Market Beef must weigh a minimum of 1100# to sell in the premium auction.
- Market Beef Market Beef must be de-horned and free of horns at time of fair check-in. Scurs must be less than 2 inches in length and not attached to the skull.
- Poultry Exhibitors must submit a declaration of fair entries to the superintendent by June 15.
- 4-H Poultry Exhibitors may show up to 10 poultry per class.
- Due to not holding a pre-fair weigh-in, there will be no Rate of Gain competition for the bucket calf show at the 2021 Labette County Fair.
- There are several State Fair Class changes including Visual Arts, Ag Mechanics, Architectural Block Construction (Construction Zone), and Rocketry. Please be sure to check the Kansas State Fair rule book for updates and changes in all project areas.
- There will not be mandatory work hours to sell at the fair this year, however there will still be some fair work days closer to fair time that all clubs will be encouraged to participate in.
