- This is the **FIRST** year we are using the Fair Entry system. ALL stall reservations will be made through this link by July 1. Pre-entries will also be made for all other pre-fair and indoor exhibits as well. The system will be opened in the middle of June and an email will go out. All will be required to pre-enter. - **REVIEW ANY SECTION** you plan to participate in this year. MANY changes have occurred. Changes have been made in the following Divisions – Entomology, Food Preservation, Forestry, Geology & Lapidary, Home Environment, Horticulture, all Space Tech Divisions, Wildlife, and Woodworking.
- Thank you cards to livestock premium sale buyers and reserve/grand champion plaques must be completed by all 4H & FFA exhibitors by Saturday, prior to picking up ribbon money.
- Livestock barns will be open 6:00 am – 11:00 pm. Barns will be locked at all other times. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
- Vet Inspection Station
 - Sunday 6 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. Open all livestock
 - Monday 7 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. Open all livestock
- 4H/FFA Exhibitor or Representative must have animals **FULLY** uncovered and ready for inspection at check-in. Also you need to assist in helping the vet and fair board member in checking your animal(s).
- Sheep - No body sheering will be allowed on the fairgrounds.
- The 4-H Council requires **each** 4-H and FFA member that participates in any competitive 4-H event during the current year, sell one book (ten tickets) of 4-H Pork Bundle Tickets.
- All animals shown in showmanship has to be shown in either a market or breeding class.
- Livestock sale premium and add-on base-bid money will be paid to 4-H/FFA Exhibitors via mail and be post marked no later than 45 days after the livestock premium sale.
- Beef - Breeding
 - 301 Light Weight
 - 302 Middle Weight
 - 303 Heavy Weight
- 2019 Sale order: market swine, market goats, market sheep, market beef
- Dairy Goats - Designate animals as 4-H OR Open Class. Animal cannot be shown in both.
- Youth showing bucket calves are not allowed to enter other market, feeder or breeding entries but may have entries in the open division.
- Free Pullorum testing will be done *June 14 from 4:00 – 6:00 p.m.* at the Labette County fairgrounds in Oswego.
