

2021 Labette County Club Day Guidelines

County Club Day will be held virtually on February 6. Due to so many uncertainties still surrounding facility use and gathering allowances, this will allow us to host club day in a safe, efficient way. We look forward to returning to an in-person club day format in 2022.

Divisions/Entry Forms:

-Entries will be due January 31. We will be using the same entry forms as usual which can be found on the Labette County 4-H Website.

-Model Meeting – Model meeting participation is a requirement for the 2021 year to obtain a purple or blue club seal. For 2021, clubs may perform a Model Meeting at any time throughout the 4-H year (October 2020-September 2021). Participation will be accepted through a copy of the minutes of that meeting showing that a model meeting was conducted. Due to the virtual club day, model meeting participation will not have to be done at club day unless the club wishes to try to advance to the regional level. To be considered for a purple or blue club seal, clubs must complete Model Meeting Suggested Guidelines 1-5 as outlined on page 3 of the Regional Club Day Guidelines.

-Once all entries have been received, participants will be scheduled for a time slot to be judged. Judging will be conducted live over Zoom in the afternoon on Saturday, February 6th. Any member that wishes to participate but does not have quality internet access is welcome to come to the extension office to participate.
