

9:00 am Sheep/Goat show order: Breeding ewes, Market lambs, Breeding

Does, and then Market goats - All classes broken by weights

<u>10:30 am</u> Pig weigh-in/Registration

<u>11:30am</u> Pig show starts with market classes *tentatively*

Breeding gilt classes will follow Market Grand Drive

<u>1:00 pm</u> Cattle weigh-in/registration

2:00 pm Cattle show to start with breeding followed by market *tentatively*

All classes will be split by weight

<u>Showmanship</u>: This year showmanship will be an invitation only. There will be a Junior and Senior showmanship class per species at the end of the final grand drive per species.

Elk Valley Spring Showcase

General Show Rules:

- Open to all bonafide 4-H and FFA members who are under 19 years old as of January 1 of the current year.
- To enter showmanship classes at no cost, a paid class entry must be made by the exhibitor.
 - Showmanship will be an invitation only this year. Judge will "invite" JR and SR showman from each species to compete in their age group per species after the final grand drive per species.
- Exhibitors are welcome to stall over the night before the show in the barns, but MUST clean up all bedding and trash before leaving the grounds after the show.
- All exhibitors are to clean up all shavings/manure/trash before leaving the grounds.
- Only one person in the waiting area with the exhibitor.
- \$20 (pre-entered) or \$25 (day of the show), made payable to Elk Valley FFA

Health Requirements:

 Show officials reserve the right to remove any animal from the grounds if it appears diseased, emaciated or extremely unthrifty. All animals are subject to examination by show officials/representatives. If injected animals are found, the entire trailer will be sent home.

Sheep/Meat Goats:

- Bring a generator.
- Exhibitors must show their own animal for showmanship classes.
- All classes, Market & Breeding, will be split by weight

- All animals must be ID'd with a registration tattoo or an official USDA premise ID tag.
- All animals shown in Market classes are NOT eligible to show in breeding classes. Market lambs may be ewes or wethers and MUST be slick shorn. NO artificial coloring allowed.


Show coordinators reserve the right to keep any individual from showing in the Showcase for any reason they deem necessary.

Swine:

- All classes, both Market and Breeding, will be split by weight
- Exhibitors must show their own animal for showmanship classes.
- All animals must be ID'd with a registration tattoo or an official USDA Premise ID tag.

Beef:

- Bring a generator.
- No fitting allowed. (No paint/No adhesive)
- All classes, both Market & Breeding, will be split by weight
- Exhibitors must show their own animal for showmanship classes.
- All animals must be ID'd with a registration tattoo or an official USDA Premise ID tag.
