Animals shown in the market classes are not eligible to show in the breeding classes and vice versa. Everyone must check in at the registration table prior to weighing. This includes in-county, out of county, breeding and market entries. Market lambs must be slick-shorn to one quarter inch, to the hock. Wool on the face and below the hock is allowed. Market Goats will be shown clipped to 3/8" or less. All classes will be split by weight.			
		All goats must be dehorned or tipped and rounded.	
		All wethers must be castrated/banded prior to coming to the show. No bucks/rams allow. The showmanship contest is open to all exhibitors and will be conducted as follows: Senior (14 and over), Intermediate (10-13), Junior (7-9). Age is determined before January 1, 2020. All animals shown in showmanship classes must be owned by the exhibitor.
