Rules:

- 1. All Exhibitors are responsible for their own bedding and their own cleanup of their bedding and trash.
- 2. There will limited stall space. Generators are encouraged.
- Entry fee of \$35 per head must be postmarked by March 15th. Bucket Calf entries are \$15 prior to March 15th.

- 4. Any entry not postmarked by March 15th will be \$45 per head and \$20 for bucket calves.
- 5. All exhibitors must check-in with the Show Committee from 7:30am to 9:00am to pick up their exhibitor number. At that time, you will need to present a copy of your breed association registration.
- 6. Show order: Heifers, Showmanship, Prospect Market, Bucket Calf
- 7. Classes may be divided if crowded conditions exist in the ring.
- 8. Exhibitors are responsible for getting their animal to the ring on time.

Two Calls per individual in a class will be all that will be called.

After that, the class will be closed, and judging will begin.

- 9. Judge's decision will be final, and prizes will be awarded accordingly.
- 10. All breeding animals will be required to have registration papers at check-in. Ear tattoos may be compared to registration papers. All questionable steers will show as crossbreds or as determined by ethics committee.
- 11. Any exception to the entry rules must be approved by the Show Committee. The Show Committee reserves the right to make any changes or exceptions necessary for the betterment of the show. All committee decisions are final.

Scales will be open on the grounds, exhibitors are responsible for turning in their own weights.

Classes will be broken by animal weight.

Must be at least 3 head to make a breed class, otherwise they will show in AOB

Supreme Champion Steer will be selected

<u>Bucket Calves</u> (Immediately following Steers)

Must be born after January 1, 2019. Criteria for judging will be based on health and condition of the animal, as well as knowledge of the animal (i.e. breed, age, and feeding practices.)

Bucket calf exhibitors must 12 or younger as of Jan 1, 2019
