### Vocational, Technical, or Trade Scholarship Application

The Wildcat Extension Education Foundation will be awarding up to \$1,000 in scholarships to graduating Wildcat District (Crawford, Labette, Wilson, and Montgomery counties) 4-H members. The funds from this scholarship can be used to either:
