Interested in receiving free plants? K-State is offering its Citizen Science program, which provides you with free plants and seeds in exchange for tracking the size, quality and yield of plants during the growing season. The following plants are available:

TOMATO TRANSPLANTS - 10 different cultivars*
PEPPER TRANSPLANTS - 10 different cultivars*
SWEETCORN SEEDS
SUMMER SQUASH SEEDS

*In order to receive pepper and tomato transplants, we must have at least one gardener or organization who can grow 30 tomatoes and/or 36 peppers in a single plot. If we do not have one, tomato and pepper transplants will not be available this year. However, sweetcorn and summer squash seeds will be available.

Plants are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. The deadline for signing up is March 1. If you or your organization are interested in participating, please contact Jesse Gilmore at jr637@ksu.edu.
